
Bagshot Station provides a 1hr 10 minute service into Waterloo via Ascot and is 0.7

## **HOUSE OVERVIEW**



OVER 15,000+ SQ FT SET IN 16 ACRES

Designed with Norman Shaw in mind, Pinewood is a substantial detached Arts and Crafts style House. One of the many typical Arts and Crafts designs can be seen in the form of a terracotta sunflower, set into the brickwork.

The property was built in 1880 for the Elphinstones, Sir Howard Elphinstone was appointed by the Prince Consort to be Governor to Prince Arthur, when the Prince was eight and half years old. He was thought to have later supervised the building of Bagshot Park and, in 1887, Sir Howard was appointed aide-de-camp to Queen Victoria.

A valued friend to both the Queen and Duke of Connaught, he died tragically at sea in 1890.




4,000+ SQ FT OF OUTBUILDINGS SET IN PRIVATE GROUNDS

The grounds of the property consist of secluded parklands that includes a histooric private lake and private gardens.
























Please note that extensive works have been completed since this floor plan has been produced, including a new basement and loft conversion, an up to date floor plan should be requested by interested parties.



#### Proposed care home elevations




NORTH ELEVATION SCALE 1:200
