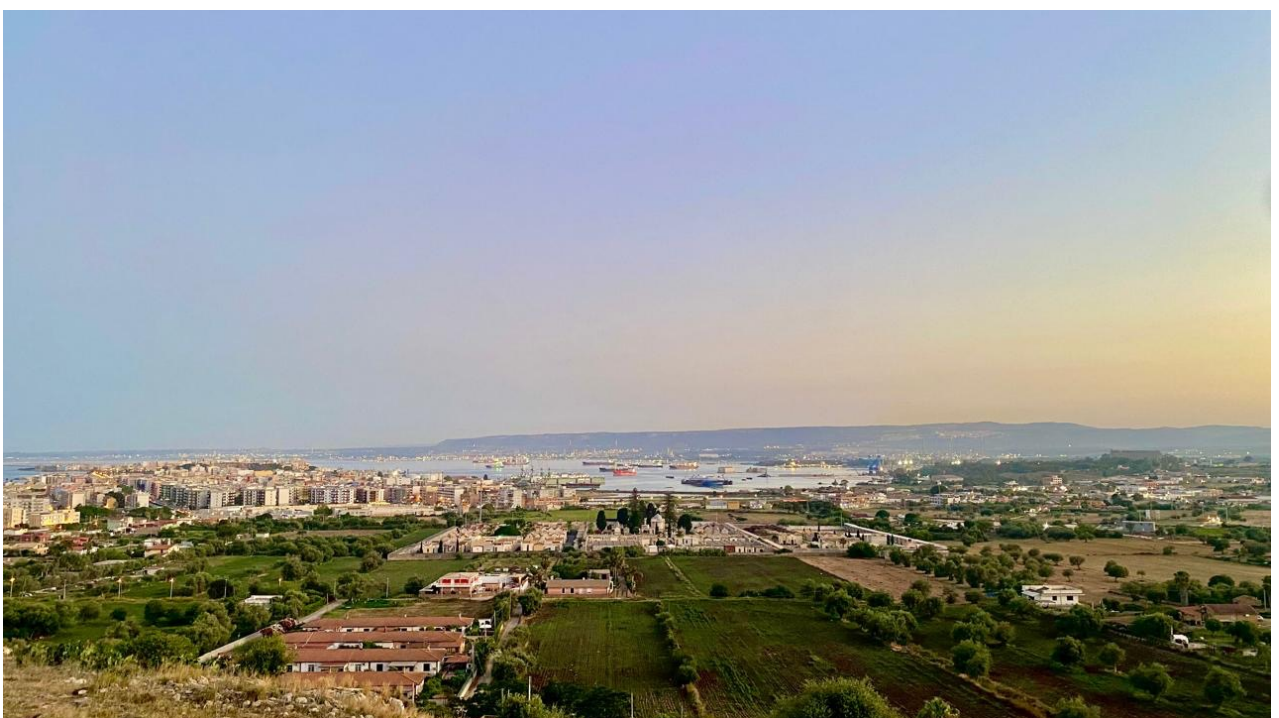
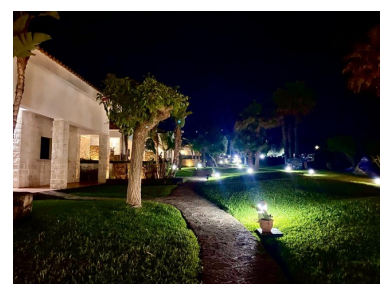
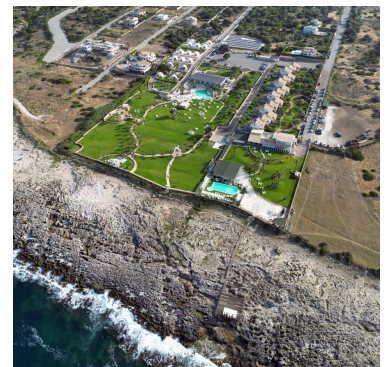




## Capo Campolato Resort Project

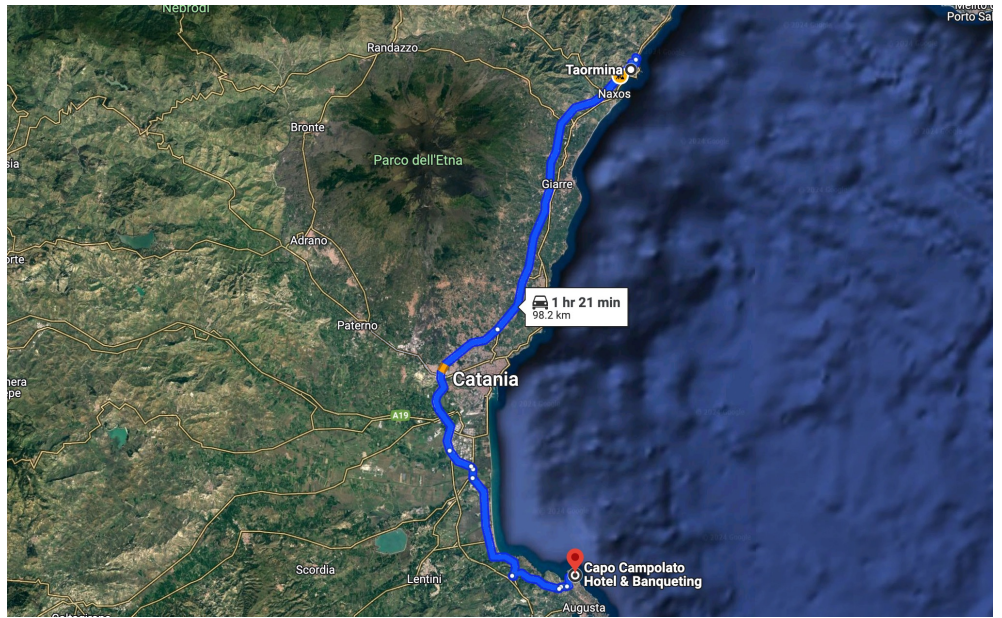


## Prime location

Capo Campolato Resort is reachable from the main tourists cities in Sicily.

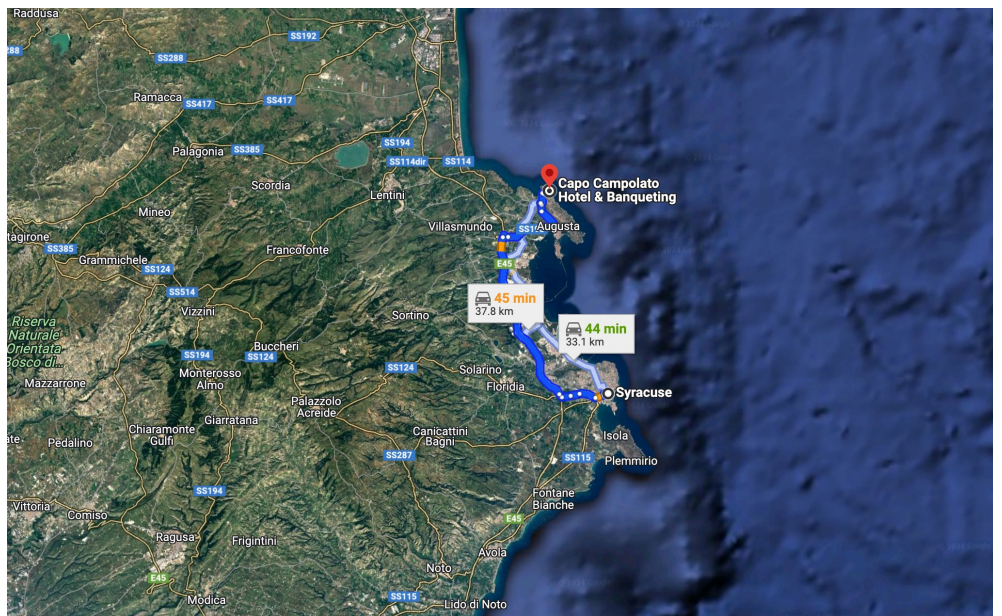
### 1 Taormina
